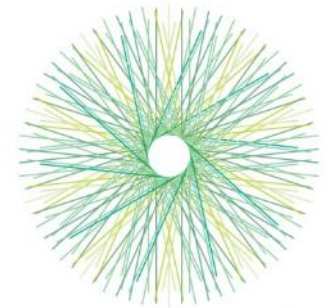

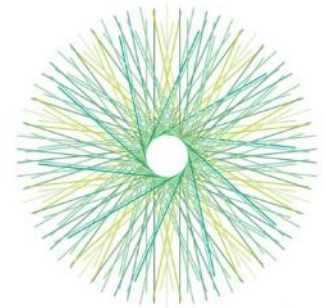

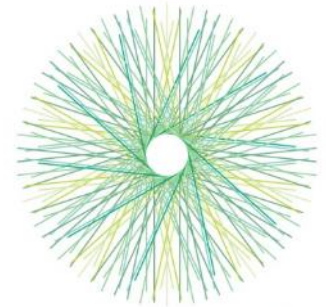
Aim: To foster a competitive and sustainable agriculture and forestry sector that "achieves more from less"

- linking actors via the EIP Network



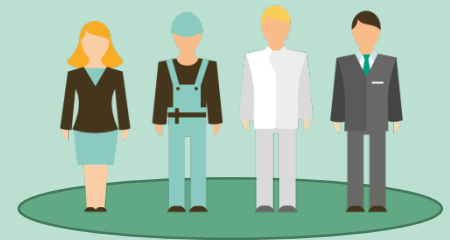

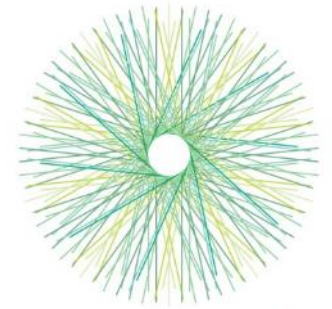

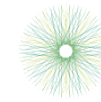

Number of planned EIP Operational Groups in the approved RDPs (2014 - 2020)

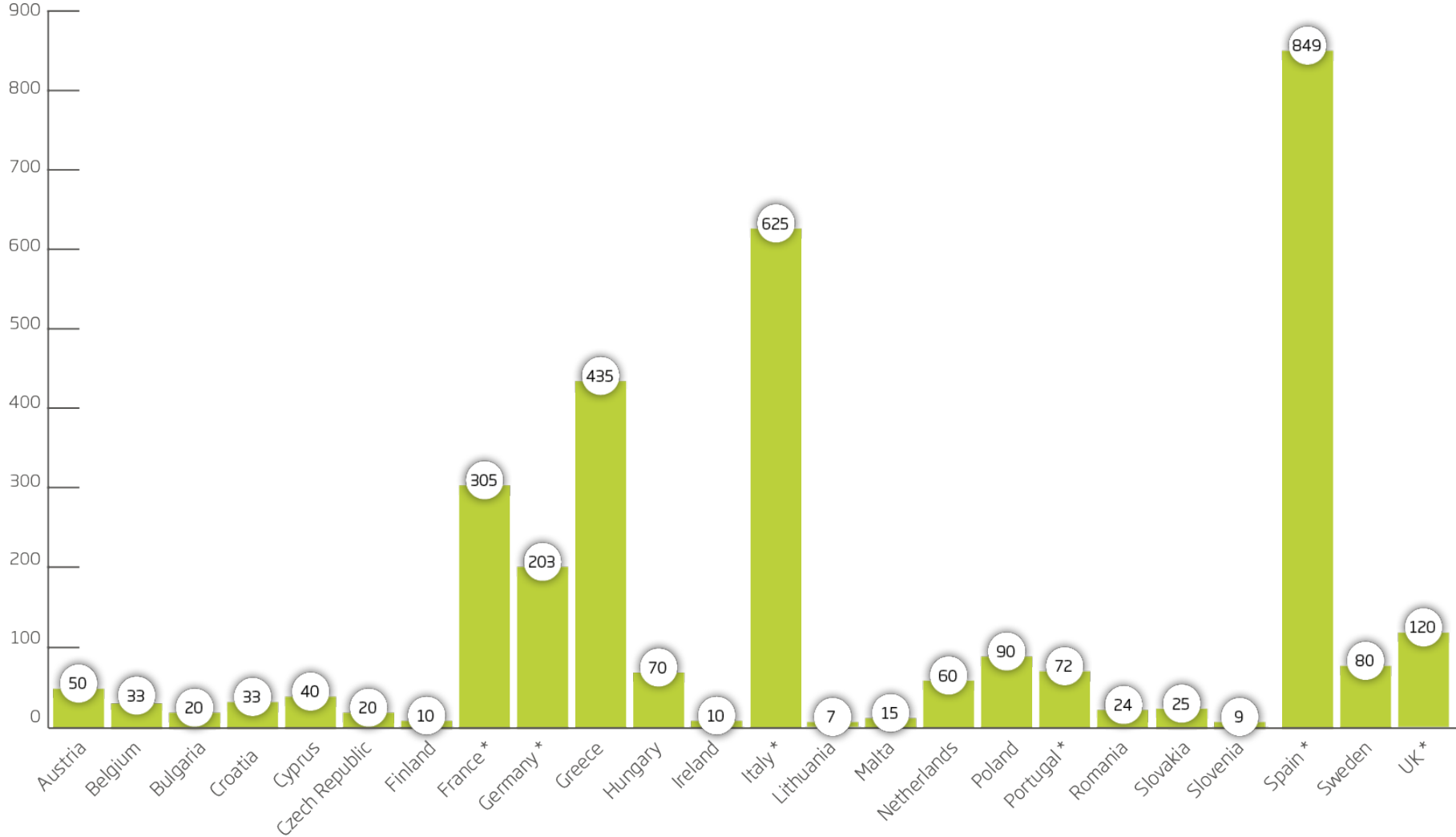

The overall purpose of this workshop was

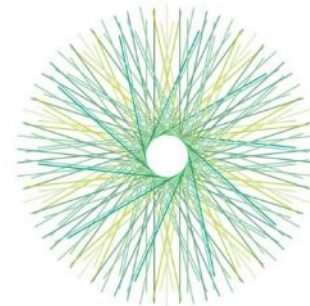
