Input from practice



Funded by the Ministry of Agriculture in Lower Saxony (Germany) a project has been conducted in the period between 2014-2020 to found a label for meadow-based products. In the absence of criteria for the production of meadow-based products a stakeholder panel has been set-up which served as co-design platform for defining production criteria. The label was introduced into the (retail-) market in 2017 and is now market leader for pasture products in Germany. It ensures that surcharges (premia) are paid to those farmers who produce pasture products according to the criteria defined by ProWeideland. Currently about 2000 farmers are contracted under ProWeideland.

Dr. Arno Krause is head of the Centre for Grasslands in Germany (Grünlandzentrum Niedersachsen Bremen e.V.) since 2011 and also General Manager of ProWeideland GmbH (subsidiary of Grassland Centre) since 2017. He was coordinator of the EU-Thematic Network "Inno4Grass" in the period between 2017-2020 and is now coordinator of the Thematic Network "Grazing4AgroEcology (2022-2025). He was active in setting-up the EIP-Agri since its beginning in 2012 and is member of the EU SCAR-AKIS group.

The modernAKIS Project

modernAKIS (www.modernakis.eu), a seven year Horizon Europe project covering all 27 EU Member States, aims to improve the capacities of AKIS actors to leverage their individual, organizational and systemic resources to drive transformation towards more coherent, effective and AKIS systems and the transition to a more sustainable management and use of natural resources in farming and forestry.

The project offers more than 50 capacity building events, 40 networking events, 7 AKIS training modules, a network and online community of AKIS actors (www.akisconnect.eu), engaged in sharing experiences and peer learning.
